






The car park above will be converted into a bedroom for Vastu reasons

Q & A WITH THE CLIENTS

A conversation with the clients to understand their needs and wants

- What is the ideal height and size of the bed they need? Bed with or without headboard? How much customisation will they require? Bed with headboard. Bed 6*6.6*1.3 feet
- Wall mounted TV or TV console? TV console could give additional storage Tv console with some storage
- Long or short mirror for the dresser? Long mirror
- How much storage/how many draws for the dresser? At least 2
- Is the seating to watch TV or read or relax? Where should it be placed? All three, wherever possible. Should be moved a
- round easily.
- Clothes hanger and laundry basket hidden or in a corner? Either
- Bedside lamp on a side-table or hanging? Either
- Bedside table should it have storage space? Yes
- Bright lights, natural light, mood lighting or a combination of the three Combination
- Fan and AC, lights placement Fan over bed, AC away from bed, lights wherever needed
- How many cupboards would be enough wardrobe space? At least 6
- Wardrobe floor to ceiling or open space above the wardrobes? not floor to ceiling
- What materials would you like to use to give the room a cozy or warm feeling? Wood/ wood finish
- Ideal size of the shower cubicle? At least 4*4 feet
- Do you want a glass or a wall divider between the shower cubicle and toilet? undecided
- Light coloured or dark coloured tiles in the bathroom? undecided
- What kind of lighting in the bathroom? Soft or bright? Combination
- Automatic lights for the bathroom? Not needed

- Cozy feel
- Earthy/neutral colours
- Should feel warm and inviting

Emotional needs (bathroom)

- should feel safe/anti-skid
- adequate ventilation





- 2. Windows are not blocked so will allow enough light inside the room
- 3.Bed and wardrobe direction are Vaastu compliant

WEAKNESS

1.Will allow more light inside the room in the afternoon and evening therefore the room could get hot. The room is slightly darker in the morning.


2.TV is a little far away from the bed

OPPORTUNITIES

- 1. There is enough space to add more furniture, move around existing furniture, add a clothes hanger etc
- 2. Chairs will allow the TV to be viewed clearly

THREATS

1.No threats



1.The room appears spacious and clutter-free

WEAKNESS


- 1.Bed faces the bathroom
- 2.TV is not easy to view because of the direction of the bed
- 3. South window is partially blocked because of the wardrobe, therefore room will be darker in the evening too

OPPORTUNITIES

1. Chairs can be moved around to suit the needs of the clients. Tv could also be viewed this way.

THREATS

1. Wardrobe has to be fit in such a way that the bedroom door does not hit the wardrobe



- 1.Art work on the wall can be given nicely without window interruptions
- 2. Windows are not blocked
- 3.TV can be viewed clearly from the bed
- 4. The divider has created a private space behind the TV. This space can therefore be used by the clients as a dressing area too

WEAKNESS

1. The bedroom door opens on to the bed - lack of privacy


Bed direction is not Vaastu compliant

OPPORTUNITIES

1. Space behind the divider offers the clients the opportunity to use it in multiple ways - storage /changing area etc

THREATS

1.Bedroom door might hit the bedside table if the table is movable



- 1. The bed, wardrobe and TV console are Vaastu compliant and at the samthe spaciousness of the room is maintained.
- 2. Windows are not blocked.
- 3.Bedroom looks and feels clutter-free
- 4.Bathroom elements are all Vaastu compliant

WEAKNESS

TV is slightly far from the bed but easier to view from the chairs

OPPORTUNITIES

Chairs can be moved around according to the needs of the clients














Layout 1 was chosen by the clients and the above is the layout with annotations













EXPERIMENTING WITH MATERIALS, FINISHES, FURNISHINGS - OPTION 1 [APPROVED BY THE CLIENT]

In Option 1, the floor is stone grey, the furniture is a combination wood & rattan, and the upholsteries are in neutral shades. The bathroom is a combination of grey & white tiles (in continuation of the theme of the room)













EXPERIMENTING WITH MATERIALS, FINISHES, FURNISHINGS - OPTION 2

In Option 2, the lights over the bedside tables have been changed to pendant lights in dark grey, and the side tables, chairs and rug have been changed to b&w to add a spot of colour to the mostly brown room. flooring remains unchanged. No changes have been made to the bathroom.












EXPERIMENTING WITH MATERIALS, FINISHES, FURNISHINGS - OPTION 3


In Option 3, the cupboard, upholstery and soft furnishings remain the same as Option 1.

The flooring has been changed for the bedroom and bathroom.


















